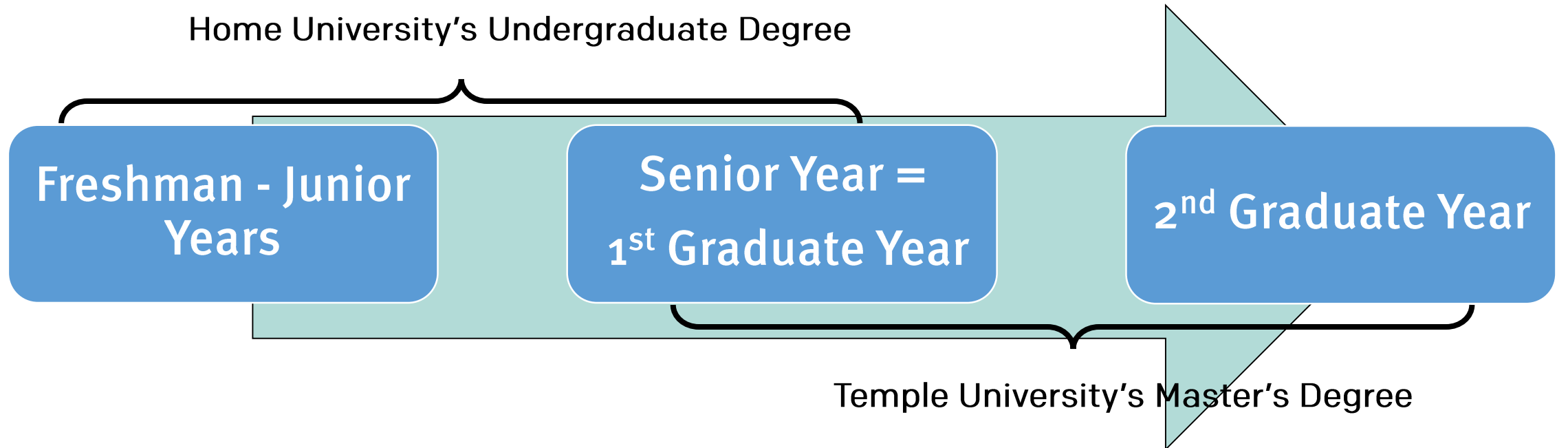
# DUAL BACHELOR'S MASTER'S DEGREE PROGRAM

- DBMD is an accelerated dual degree program
- Earn your Bachelor's from home institution, your Master's from Temple
- Apply in your junior (3<sup>rd</sup>) or senior (4<sup>th</sup>) year
- Complete both degrees in only 5 years



# HOW DOES DBMD WORK?

Students spend 3 or 4 years at their home institution and 2 years at Temple. At the conclusion of the program, they have a bachelor's degree from the home university and a master's degree from Temple.





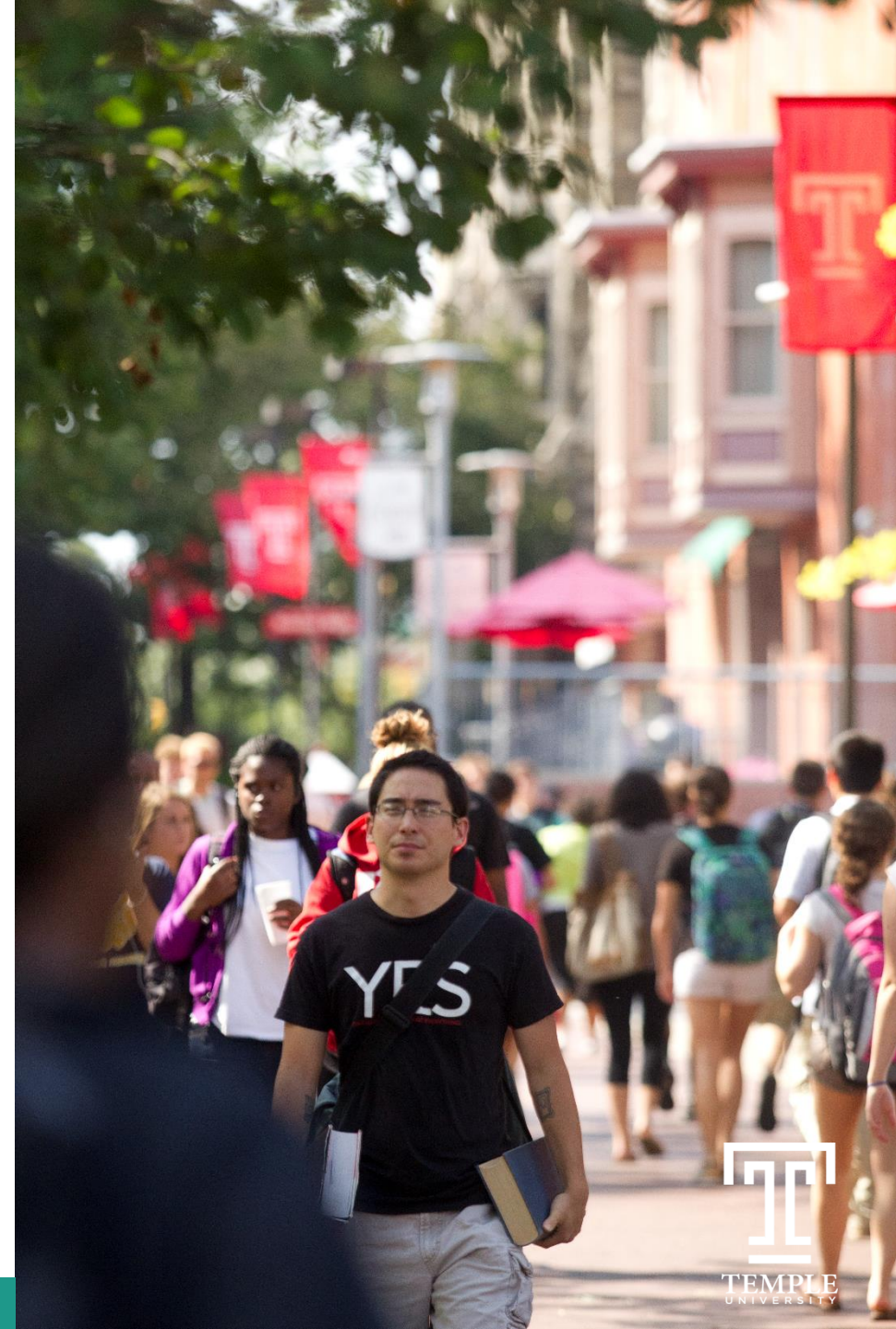
# DBMD BENEFITS

- Scholarship opportunities
- GRE waived (except for Fox School of Business)
- Early admission into Graduate School
- Bachelor's and Master's in just 5 years
- Guidance and support with application, housing, and academic advising
- Graduate Assistantships available in 2<sup>nd</sup> year (up to 100% tuition remission and stipend)
- STEM programs offer the opportunity to stay in the U.S. and work for up to three years after graduating on Optional Practical Training (OPT).
- DBMD student trips and activities



# DBMD REQUIREMENTS

- Open to students in their 3<sup>rd</sup> or 4<sup>th</sup> year with 3 or fewer remaining courses
- GPA 3.0/4.0 (Preferred)
- TOEFL Internet-based (iBT) 79 (Minimum)
  - Fox Business School 100
  - Media and Communications 100
- IELTS Academic 6.5
  - Fox Business School 7.5
  - Media and Communications 7
- GMAT or GRE required for Business applicants; at least 65<sup>th</sup> percentile

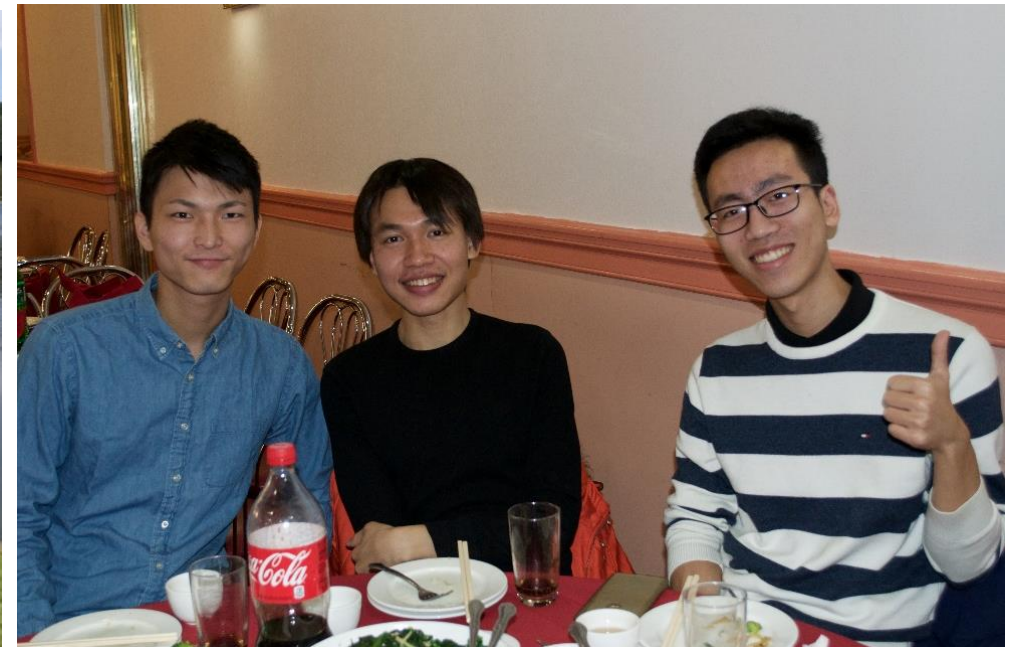

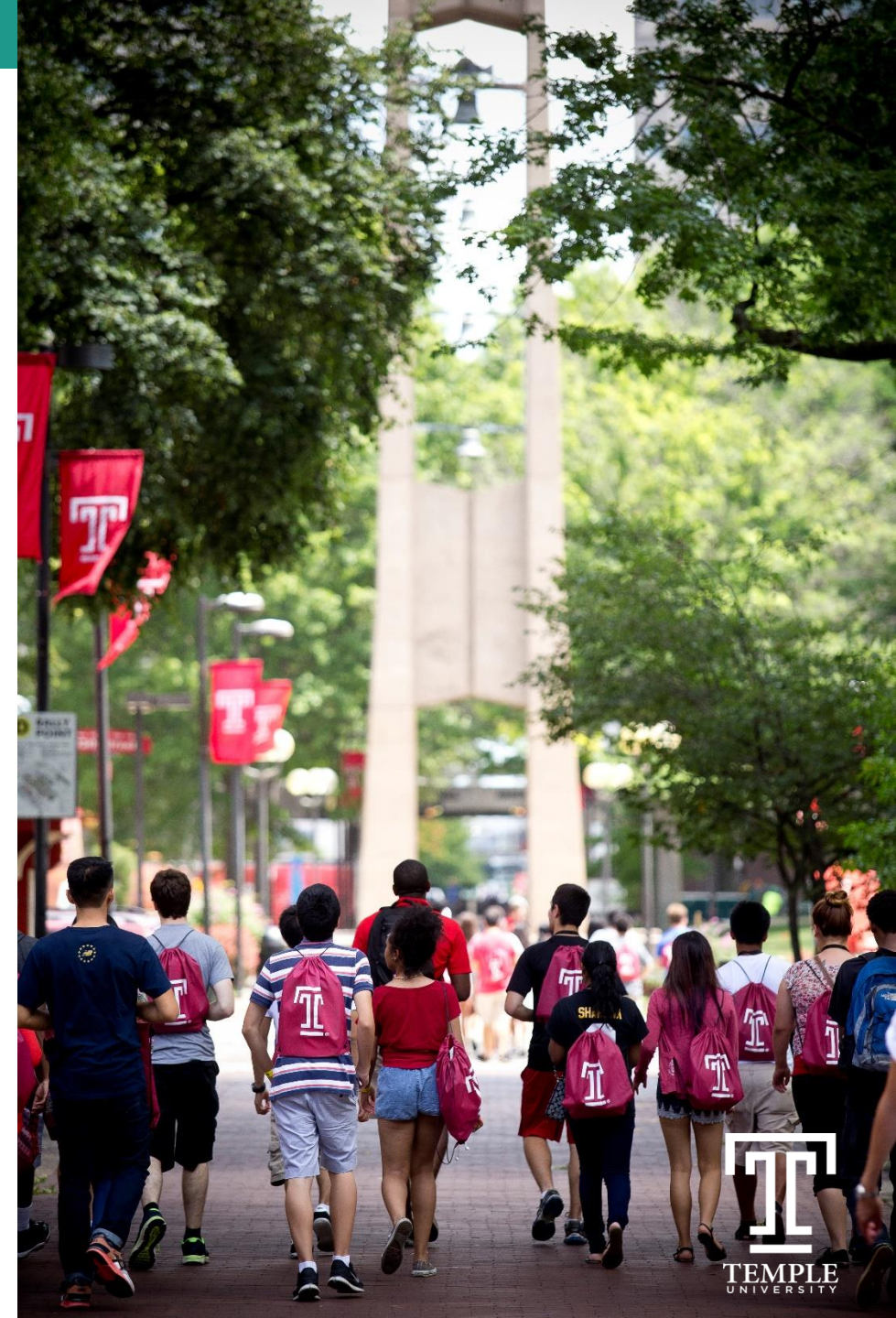
