The Tokyo International Exchange Center (TIEC) is a large dormitory for international students run by Japan Student Services Organization (JASSO). JASSO now accepts applications for graduate students as stated below. Those who wish to apply for residence at the TIEC need to submit the necessary documents to the International Student Office no later than the due date. Residents will be decided through an interview at the university and the following material screenings by JASSO.

1. **Location:** 2-2-1 Aomi, Koto-ku, Tokyo (Tokyo Academic Park, Odaiba area)
2. **Access:** 3 minute walk from Fune-no-Kagakukan Station on the Yurikamome Line
15 minute walk from Tokyo Teleport Station on the Rinkai Line
1 minute walk from Fune-no-Kagakukan bus stop
3. **Qualifications:**(1)Applicant must be either a government or self funded graduate student enrolled or planning to enroll in a Japanese University within commuting distance of the TIEC.
(2)Applicant must obtain a "College Student" visa status.
4. **Available Rooms:** Single room in Hall A: 3 rooms, Single room in Hall B: 1 rooms,
Family room in Hall D: 1 room
5. **Period of Residence: Until March 31, 2012 (Extension will not be permitted)**
6. **Cost:** Single Room (20 square meters) in Hall A **35,000 yen / month**
Single Room (30 square meters) in Hall B **45,000 yen / month**
Family Room (100 square meters, 3LDK) in Hall D **75,000 yen / month**
Plus a non-refundable move-in fee of one month's rent. Utilities are not included.
7. **Room Description:** [Single] shower, toilet, sink, air conditioner, bed, bedding, chair, desk, refrigerator, phone etc
[Couple/Family] bath, toilet, sink, kitchen (with electric range), bed, bedding, sofa,
dining table, chair, desk, refrigerator, air conditioner, washer/dryer, phone etc.

8. **Necessary Documents:**

 - ②Application for Tokyo International Exchange Center (JASSO Form 1-1)
 - ③Proposal for Implementation / Participation of Exchange Activities at TIEC (Form 3)
 - ④Both Sides Copy of Foreign Registration Card

9. **Application Process:** Interested students should submit the required documents to the International Office by 5pm on April 28, 2011. Interviews will take place by the middle of May at the International Office.
10. **Results:** If selected, students will be informed by the end of May.
11. **Selection:** After the interview at the International Office, the selected candidates will be screened based on the following criteria by JASSO. Please note that Meiji University has no influence on the final decision made by JASSO.
 - (1) Those who can proactively participate in various international exchange events organized by JASSO.
 - (2) Those who arrived in Japan within one year will be given priority.
 - (3) Candidates' nationality and university may be considered in order to welcome as various nationalities and universities as possible.
 - (4) Expected long-term residents at TIEC may be given priority.
 - (5) Number of Japanese RA residents may be considered.
