

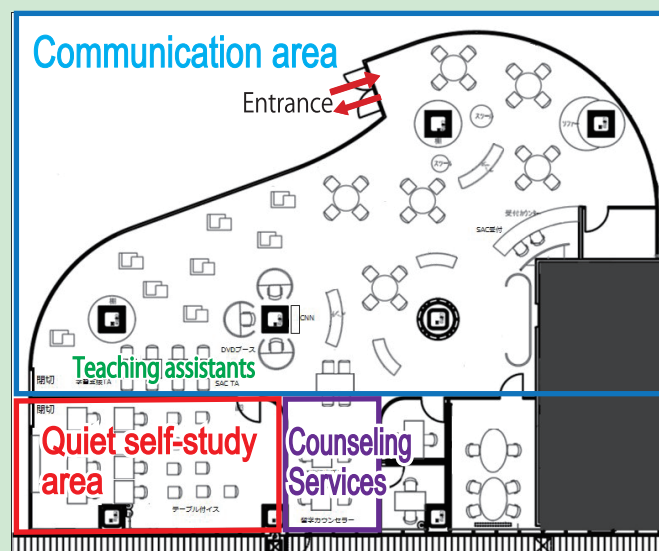
New Self-Access Center from June 1, 2017

What students can do in the current Self-Access Center?

It is a place for Meiji students to do self-study (located on the first floor). English language learning materials, movies, rental PCs, and study counseling services by teaching assistants are available. In addition, there is a room equipped with presentation devices such a projector and a video camera, and two speaking booths are available (reservations required).

How will it change?

The New Self-Access Center includes the functions of both the current Self-Access Center and the Nakano International Exchange Lounge. The new Self-Access Center will be divided into two areas, a communication area where students may converse with other Japanese and international students, and a quiet self-study area. (Self-study in the communication area is also allowed.) A brief overview of the New Self-Access Center is as follows.



【Hours】

Monday – Friday, 9:00am – 6:00pm

Study Materials & Study Rooms

English language study materials, movies, and devices such as portable DVD players and headphones can be borrowed at the reception counter by showing a student ID card. Most borrowed items may be used only inside the Self-Access Center, but some materials may be borrowed for home use. Speaking booths and a room equipped with presentation devices are also available (reservations required).

Counseling Services

Counseling services by teaching assistants, a Nakano International Student Section staff member, and a study abroad counselor are available in the communication area. The counseling service schedule will be announced later.

Food & Drink Policy

Communication area: Food and drinks are allowed. However, only drinks in covered containers or capped bottles are allowed when using Self-Access Center rental PCs.

Quiet self-study area: Food is not allowed and only drinks in covered containers or capped bottles are allowed.

Notes: The University reserves the right to change its Food and Drink Policy if students damage facilities/ equipment or leave garbage in the Self-Access Center.
