

Meiji University was founded in January 1881 as Meiji Law School by a group of young lawyers barely in their 30's: Tatsuo Kishimoto, Kozo Miyagi, and Misao Yashiro. It was an era characterized by Japan's urgent need to develop as a modern independent nation. The three founded Meiji Law School in their fervent hope to "foster bright capable youths who would lead a modern civil society in Japan". As the affiliate school of Meiji University, the school takes on the same spirit.

Education Policies

The schools' education policy has the following six major characteristics.

- 1. Development of students that will form the core of Meiji University
- 2. Passing down the spirit of the school motto
- 3. Focus on investigative learning
- 4. Development of people with basic humanity
- 5. Balances intellectual, moral, and physical education
- 6. Close collaboration between the school and parents
