



The financial aid system for international students will be revised from AY 2026. Details may be subject to change, but the main revisions are outlined below. Please check our website and guidelines for detailed information. Meiji University selects and determines recipients of scholarships and other grants from among eligible applicants listed in the table below who apply after enrollment. Note that no application is required for the grant listed as III in the table below.

I Meiji University Scholarship for Privately Financed International Students

(※) Available after enrollment

- This scholarship is intended to provide support to students who are experiencing difficulties in studying in Japan.

II Meiji University Grant for Academic Excellence for Privately Financed International Students (※) Available after enrollment

(Formerly : Meiji University Tuition Assistance (Reduction) Program for Privately Financed International Students)

- In order to encourage academic achievement, the grant will be awarded to students who achieve excellent academic results after enrollment.
