(*1) Mid-Term Presentation

• Students shall conduct Mid-Term Presentation before applying for Public Hearing. Faculty members and students of GSGG are allowed to participate in the presentation.

 \cdot The supervisor determines if his/her student(s) can apply for Public Hearing or not, following the result of the presentation.

(*2) Conditions for Public Hearing

• The applicant must have a session with examiners to obtain their agreement to go to Public Hearing.

• Faculty Committee formally approves Public Hearing based on the examiners' judgement.

(*3) Preliminary evaluation (Public Hearing)

: Members of Faculty Committee, students, outside researchers will be invited to join

• Judging whether the candidate is eligible to apply for the degree.

• Public Hearing and examiners' assessment should be done as soon as possible after Faculty Committee formally approves Public Hearing.

• The Q/A session will be based on the subject of the examination.

• Candidates will be asked to rewrite the dissertation according to comments which were raised at the Public Hearing.

(*4) Oral defense

: Only nominated examining members will participate

• Final screening of the dissertation.

• It should be held as soon as possible after Faculty Committee formally accepts the submission of dissertation (2^{nd} time) .

· Candidates will be asked to rewrite the dissertation based on the screening result.
