

Meiji University Student Emergency Grant (AY2020)
Application Form

1 Outline of Support

Meiji University (the University) will give financial support to those students, 1) who have experienced a significant decrease in household income due to novel coronavirus infections, and 2) who have experienced financial difficulties in continuing their studies at the University.

2 Students qualified for support

Students of the University (undergraduate, graduate, and professional graduate school students, including international students) who fall under any of the following and require support due to financial difficulty.

- (1) Loss of employment of the householder (or closed one's independent business)
- (2) Experienced a significant decrease in income due to business slump of the householder's workplace
- (3) Experienced a significant decrease in income due to business slump of householder's independent business
- (4) Loss of Householder
- (5) Experienced a significant decrease in student's income from a part-time job
- (6) Other reasons where financial support is considered necessary

3 Grant

4 Number of Recipients

Up to 5,000 students

5 Documents to prove sudden changes in household income

Recipients of the Grant must keep the documents listed below and submit a copy whenever requested from the University. Note that the full amount of the Grant must be returned if the recipient does not submit the documents.

- Evidence of decrease in family income or student's income from part-time jobs over the last six months (e.g., wage slip, bankbook which shows the payment from the workplace)
- Other income-related documents

6 Application Method

Students who wish to apply for the Grant must apply via the questionnaire form of "Oh-o! Meiji" during the application period.

* In the "Reasons for Application," describe the necessity of receiving the Grant in detail, such as a significant decrease in income, which resulted in difficulties in continuing to study at Meiji University. (More than 200 words)

8 Selection Procedures

The screening will be conducted based on the contents of the application in accordance with the degree of difficulty of the household income. (Not all applicants will be selected as recipients.) Note that we do not respond to any inquiries regarding selection procedures.

9 Announcement of Results

Results will be announced via "Oh-o! Meiji" on Tuesday, June 2, 2020. (Tentative)
Note that we do not respond to any inquiries regarding selection results.

10 Date of provision

11 Payment Method

The Grant will be transferred to the bank account that was registered at the time of application.

12 Refund of Grant

The University will request a refund of the Grant when recipients fall under any of the following.

- (1) If the recipient did not submit the copy of necessary documents when requested
- (2) If the declaration is found incorrect or false
- (3) If a student withdraws from school by March 31, 2021
- (4) If the Grant is deemed to be unnecessary
