In response to the need to conduct maintenance and for operational reasons relating to the holding of the 2026 Academic Year Entrance Exams, access to the following areas will be restricted. Thank you for your cooperation.

1. Buildings subject to restricted access with timeframe

Surugadai Campus

- (1) Liberty Tower: February 4 (Wed.) February 19 (Thu.)
- (2) Faculty Office Building: February 4(Wed.) February 19 (Thu.)
- (3) Academy Common(2F 3F): February 4 (Wed.) February 5 (Thu.)
 Academy Common(2F 3F): February 15 (Sun.) February 16 (Mon.)
- *Academy Common (1F): Access to some areas on the first floor will be restricted due to entrance and exit of personnel involved in the exams. If the Academy Common (2F–3F) is not used as an examination venue for the School of Commerce, access restrictions on February 15 (Sun.) and 16 (Mon.) will not be implemented.

Izumi Campus

February 4 (Wed.) - February 16 (Mon.)

* Entry to some buildings on campus may be restricted for entrance examination preparation. Only faculty, people connected with the exams, or those with specific permission may enter such buildings from February 3 (Tue.).

Ikuta Campus

- (1) Main Building (Administration Offices): February 4 (Wed.)- February 7 (Sat.)
- (2) Area 1 Building-No.2 (West): February 4 (Wed.) February 7 (Sat.)
- (3) Area 2 Building-A (2F 4F): February 4(Wed.) February 7 (Sat.)
- (4) Dining Hall Square21: February 4(Wed.)- February 5 (Thu.)
- *If Ikuta Campus Area 1 Building–No.2 (West) and Area 2 Building-A will not be used as examination venues for the School of Science and Technology, access restrictions will be lifted from February 6 (Fri.).

Nakano Campus

February 4(Wed.) – February 5 (Thu.)

- *Additional notifications will be posted if the examination venues are to be used for exams on dates other than those listed.
- 2. Measures in place during the period of restricted access
- (1) Only exam takers, faculty members, related parties, and other personnel given specific permission may enter the restricted locations. Exam takers are not permitted to enter the examination venues prior to their exam date and time.
- (2) Additional notifications will be posted if Building No. 12 at the Surugadai Campus, are to be used as examination venues.
- (3) The use of facilities in restricted buildings and areas will be prohibited.
- (4) Please check your respective department's bulletin board for details regarding how current students are to be dealt with administratively.
- (5) Please check the library website for more details regarding operating hours.
- The Central Library will be accessible, excluding Sundays and February 5 (Thu.) . Please be aware that a different entrance will be used during the restricted access period.
- The Izumi Library will be closed.
- The Ikuta Library will be open.
- The Nakano Library will be accessible, excluding Sundays, public holidays, February 4 (Wed.) and February 5 (Thu.).
- The Law Library will be closed.
- (6) Meiji University Museum and The Aku Yu Memorial Hall will be closed only when entry restrictions are enforced at the Academy Common.
