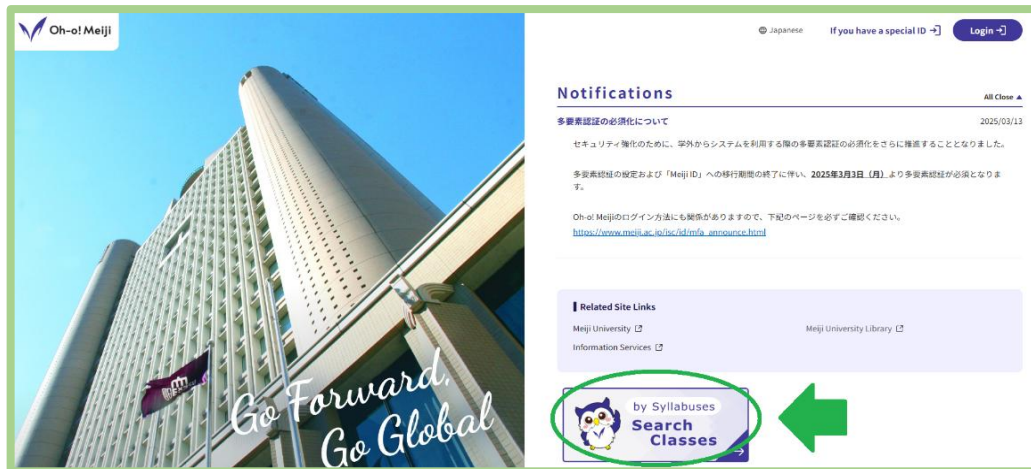
How to find syllabus on Oh-o!Meiji System
