1 What is the Top School Seminar?

(1) Overview

This program welcomes teachers and researchers from overseas universities regarded as "top schools" from the world for a short period of time or for several years to <u>offer</u> <u>lectures in English</u> in their specialized fields such as politics, economics, sociology, administration, and history. The short-term Intensive courses is offered in Spring and Fall Semester and lasts for about four to seven weeks.

 - Classes are offered in the lecturers' own styles.
 - The program will improve your English comprehensive competence and also broaden your knowledge in specialized areas.

- The program is suitable for both preparing prior to your overseas study and maintaining and enhancing your English ability after your study overseas.

- (3) Registration of the classes and credit handling
 - ① To register the Top School Seminar courses
 You can register these courses through the regular course registration method (by
 Web) during the regular course registration period (from Tuesday 4/16 to Thursday
 4/18). The credits for the courses are treated as the same as the other subjects in
 the rules regarding the handling of credits. For the class contents, please refer to
 "Syllabus 2 (class outline)" and Oh-o! Meiji.

[Registering these courses by the students of the other schools of Meiji University] If you belong to other schools of Meiji University and wish to take the Top School Seminar classes, the classes that you take can be treated as "elective courses from other schools.". In accordance with the requirements of your school and course registration rules, please register your class online in April as usual.

② In many cases, short-term intensive classes of visiting professors do not have the examination during the regular Final Examination period due to the length of their

stay. The evaluation procedures vary depending on the lecturers, such as taking examination on the last day of the class, or submitting reports or taking quiz.


