

- English Track 2018 Transfer Student (The School of Global Japanese Studies)-

The School of Global Japanese Studies (SGJS) aims to promote international education so that students will be able to contribute to the global community, based on their deep understanding of Japanese and international studies as well as their experiences in international academic exchange. In this program, students are able to earn all the credits of the SGJS in English and obtain a degree of Bachelor of Global Japanese Studies.

In 2013, the transfer admission for fall semester started in the English Track.

Transfer students to the English Track are able to enter only in September. (There is no April entry.)

Application Eligibility	<p>* Applicants who cannot submit ③ should meet either one of the following criteria: Scored <u>500 or above</u> on the <i>Critical Reading</i> AND <i>Writing</i> sections of the Old SAT (both scores must be from the same test day) taken before February 2016, scored <u>27 or above</u> on the <i>Reading Test</i> AND <u>28 or above</u> on the <i>Writing and Language Test</i> of the New SAT (both scores must be from the same test day) taken after March 2016, scored <u>18 or above</u> on the <i>English section</i> of ACT, or have received <u>their primary and secondary education (12 years in principle) in English</u> and are able to provide documentary evidence.</p>
