 - 1) Practitioners or researchers who have an international track record in architectural, urban, and regional design and practice related to the revitalization and utilization of spatial resources, as well as in research from an environmental, spatial, and social perspective related to cities and regions, and who are trying to open up new perspectives, frameworks, and methods.
 - 2) There is no nationality requirement. Foreign applicants are welcome.
 - 3) The applicant should have a track record of extensive international experience in the field of architecture and urban design
 - 4) The applicant should have several outstanding design achievements in the field of architecture and urban design, or a doctoral degree (or equivalent). It is desirable to have a degree or a professional qualification from abroad.
 - 5) The applicant should have a specific field of research or practice in Japan and/or abroad.

- 6) The applicant must be able to teach "Architecture and Urban Design Studies" as a research course and "Advanced Design Studio" as a practical course. The applicant may be assigned additional lecture courses.
- 7) The applicant must be able to lead and supervise students in practical training and workshops in Japan and abroad.
- 8) The applicant must be able to carry out educational and research activities that are internationally extensive.
- 9) The applicant must be able to give lectures, supervise research and practical training, and conduct research exchanges in English within a fully English track program.
- 10) The applicant must be able to actively participate in the management of the program.




