- Professor Malle's research focuses on social cognition (intentionality, mental state inferences, explanations), moral psychology (blame, guilt, norms), and humanrobot interaction (moral competence in robots, socially assistive robotics). He uses a wide variety of methodologies, including text content analysis, observations of social interaction, eye tracking, and reaction times.
- He was recipient of the Society of Experimental Social Psychology Outstanding Dissertation award in 1995 and of a National Science Foundation CAREER award in 1997. In 2009, he was president of the Society of Philosophy and Psychology.
