Last year, there were two major developments in U.S. Climate Law which pointed in opposite directions. On the one hand, the Inflation Reduction Act dedicates over \$394 billion in funding

for clean energy and climate projects. On the other hand, the Supreme Court struck down a key regulation of carbon emissions by the Obama Administration. What do these developments mean for the future of U.S. policy? This lecture examines these and other current trends, and examines how they will shape future reductions in carbon emissions.
