She also co-edited Paradigm Shifts in ICT Ethics: Proceedings of the ETHICOMP 2020 (2020). Recent papers include studies on emotional design in serious games and e-learning criteria for Ph.D. programs. Her works span ethics, digitalization, education, and organizational development.
