②研究概要 / Outline of Research

Enhancing Intercultural Competencies: Pedagogical Innovation and Program Level Assessment - This research will explore how to increase intercultural competencies at the program level by: (1) conceptualizing intercultural effectiveness; (2) defining 'Global Mindset' within the context of assurance of learning at the school level; (3) measuring intercultural competencies (via pre/post assessments); and (4) utilizing a virtual platform for study abroad students that increases the intensity of the learning experience through reflection practice.

③招聘期間中の研究活動の実績 / The research results as Guest Professor・Guest

Although my visit was shortened from the original plan, I established a foundation for future collaboration. I had an excellent discussion with Professor Ushimaru, Professor Suzui, and Professor Yamashita regarding possible future initiatives between the two schools based on my expertise in the field of intercultural competencies. Through the years of my collaborating experiences with several partnership universities most of which were integrated into my research, I suggest collaborative work on creating a rubric for assessing competencies which in turn can be used for students' developing their portfolio. According to my research on the rubric for fostering students to become global resources, there must be certain features or characteristics to be considered in accordance with the global resources progams that Meiji University offers. We will continue working on this theme in the futue. I would like to invite Meiji Keiei professors to related conferences in Canada to obtain the latest information and further discuss the research matter in the next future.
