①研究課題 / Research Theme

EXHIBITION/RESEARCHING ivars MULTIPLE: ONE THOUSAND X ONE - ONE X ONE THOUSAND

②研究概要 / Outline of Research

In the two exhibitions, MIL X UNO and UNO X MIL, ivars MÚLTIPLE, Tokyo 2024 that are presented respectively at the Spanish Embassy in Japan and at the Instituto Cervantes in Tokyo, a selection of eight works by Joaquín Ivars made between 2019 and 2024 are shown, six unpublished and two completed with respect to their first version. Of all of them, four have been made during a one-year stay, 2023/2024, thanks to the Recualification Aid of the Government of Spain through the University of Malaga and hosted by the Yamamoto Lab of the Meiji University for the production and research in Japan of this artist and university professor. From an extensive experience of more than 30 years of artistic work, this selection is intended to be a recent example of the multiplicity and complexity of interests of this Spanish author with an international career.

En todas las obras aquí mostradas se aproximan y tensan lo individual y lo social mediante el uso de distintas herramientas técnicas y conceptuales. Las temáticas que atraviesan ambas exposiciones están alimentadas por factores de diversa í ndole: psicológicos, económicos, generacionales, identitarios, autorreferenciales, mediáticos, filosóficos, sociopolíticos, etc., y se manifiestan en una suerte de vaivén permanente entre lo Uno y lo Múltiple.

A pesar de tener distintos puntos de partida, estas dos exposiciones confluyen y vibran juntas en una suerte de espacio mó vil de pensamiento que Ivars califica como esponjoso (en el sentido de poroso, abierto, transitable...). Así, la binariedad que utiliza —operada por los títulos propuestos para las exposiciones y por el doble espacio expositivo, entre otros aspectos má s artísticos—, no supone más que el escenario sobre el que la complejidad y la paradoja desarrollan sus roles como personajes protagonistas. De esta puesta en escena surgen otros personajes y tránsitos que activan el caudal de múltiples interpretaciones.

③招聘期間中の研究活動の実績 / The research results as Guest Professor・Guest Scholar

As a guest lecturer at Meiji University through the Yamamoto Lab, I had the opportunity to show my work in the Lab's master's program to all the students and then to have their collaboration in the production of the play My Panic- My Trust, very much in line with what has come to be called the Risk Society and then even more dramatically the Post-Trust Society. The collaboration with the students and the facilities offered by Professor Yamamoto at the facilities of the Ikuta branch of Meiji University in both events have been highly stimulating and have led to highly satisfactory results that could be seen in the exhibitions that took place at the Spanish Embassy in Japan, Roppongi, and at the Instituto Cervantes in Tokyo, Chiyoda-Ku.

These works/researches will later be exhibited and researched in Europe through seminars, conferences and presentations.
