	2) Students who can attend all necessary meetings *
	*October 12 th (Sat.), 26 th (Sat.), November 9 th (Sat.), and December 7 th (Sat.)
	3) Students who can participate all day on the day of the contest
2) Recruited number of students	15 students (If there are a large number of applicants, the Japanese Language Education Center will conduct the selection.)

5) Selection	The Japanese Language Education Center will make a comprehensive judgment based on the contents of your response to the application form. *Selection Results will be informed to all applicants via Oh-o!Meiji after October 1 (TBD).
6) Speech Theme	Please consider freely the content of your presentation based on the following themes designated by the Japanese Language Education Center (please refrain from promoting specific organizations or products).

	(Hello Japan! This is Where I Come From!)"
	What are some things, places, traditions, or other things from your home town/country that you would like to share with people in Japan? Please also tell us what it means to you.
