

How to apply for Scholarships Offered by Foundations

1. What are “scholarships offered by foundations?”

They are scholarships for privately financed students offered by public interest incorporated foundations.

*Please note that Monbukagakusho Honors Scholarship for Privately Financed International Students is not included in the scholarships offered by foundations.

2. Application Types

(1) Open Application

Students apply directly to the foundation. Students who meet the eligibility requirements can apply. Meiji University does not conduct an internal screening.

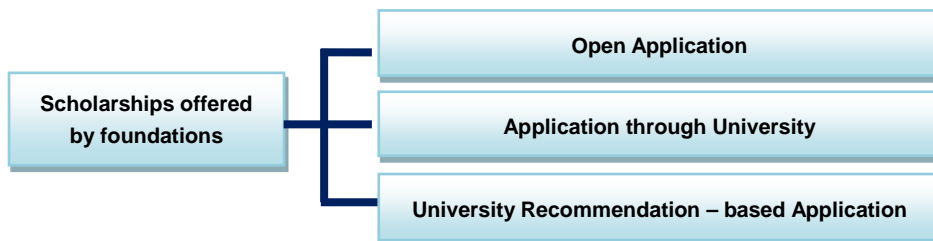
(2) Application through University

Students apply for scholarships offered by foundations through Meiji University. Meiji University does not conduct an internal screening. Students who meet the eligibility requirements can apply.

(3) University Recommendation-based Application

Foundations ask Meiji University to recommend candidates.

The university conducts an internal screening and recommends the candidates to the foundations.

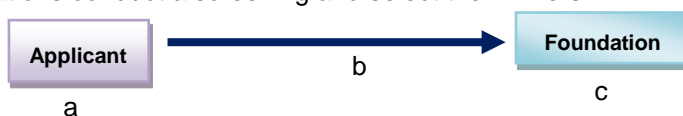


3. Application methods for scholarships offered by foundations

Refer to the foundations' websites (only for Open Application), Meiji University website and bulletin board for the information regarding scholarships offered by foundations. Submit the required documents listed on the guidelines. Details for application methods are as below.

(1) Open Application

- Refer to application guidelines and prepare the required documents.
- Apply to foundations by designated date.
- Foundations conduct a screening and select the winners.



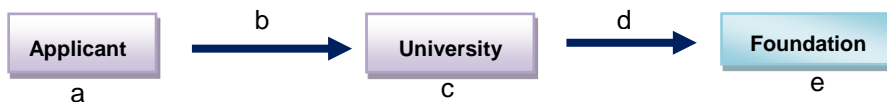
(2) Application through University

- a. Refer to application guidelines and prepare the required documents.
- b. Apply to the International Student office/ Nakano Campus Administrative Office (Number 4 Counter, 3F, Low-rise Wing) by designated date.
- c. Meiji University submits the application documents to foundations.
- d. Foundations conduct a screening and select the winners.



(3) University Recommendation-based Application

- a. Refer to application guidelines and prepare the required documents
- b. Apply to the International Student office/ Nakano Campus Administrative Office (Number 4 Counter, 3F, Low-rise Wing) by designated date.
- c. Meiji University conducts an internal screening and select candidates.
- d. Meiji University recommends the candidates to foundations.
- e. Foundations conduct a screening and select the winners.



4. Note

(2) Applying for multiple scholarships

A student IS ALLOWED to apply to university for more than one scholarship which prohibits the acceptance of multiple awards. However, university gives him/her a recommendation for only one scholarship in the final stage.
