

Application Guidelines for the Meiji University Scholarship for Privately Financed International Students 【2026 Fall Semester】

1. Eligibility

Applicants need to meet all of the following requirements.

- (1) Privately-funded international students (*) enrolled in a degree course.
(*) Excluding students who are exempted from the tuition fees, such as Exchange students, MEXT scholarship students, JDS Fellows.
- (2) Students in need of financial assistance to pursue their study/research.

(*1) Definition of Monthly Housing Rent

The total amount of rental fees, common area fees, and management fees (does not include other expenses (deposit, key money, various insurance premiums, bicycle parking fees, etc.))

(*2) Excluding students in the International Program in Architecture and Urban Design (I-AUD) and the Course in Places, Arts and Consciousness within the Graduate School of Architecture and Urbanism Program.

- (3) Students who hold a valid "Student" status of residence (RYUGAKU) as of Thursday, October 8, 2026.
*If you do not have a valid "Student" status of residence as of the date mentioned above, you may apply if you meet one of the following requirements:
 - Students who have applied for COE at the International Student Office by 17:00 on Thursday, October 8, 2026.
 - Students who have taken the necessary procedures related to gaining "Student" status of residence at the International Student Office by 17:00 on Thursday, October 8, 2026. (E.g., Renewing validity period, Changing resident status).
- (4) Students who haven't repeated any grade during the 2026 academic year.
*Note: Students with grade repetition due to a leave of absence in the past academic year may be eligible. Please consult with the International Student Office in advance in that case.
- (5) Students who did NOT take and will NOT take a leave of absence during the fall semester of the 2026 academic year.
- (6) Students who are currently not receiving or applying for any scholarships from external foundations that do not allow duplicate receipt.
- (7) Students who are NOT currently or have NOT previously been selected as recipients of the "Meiji University Graduate School Research Scholarship."

<Outline of Meiji University Graduate School Research Scholarship >

-A scholarship for the graduate school students. It provides an amount equivalent to half of the tuition fees for the standard period of study. However, continuation in the second and third years may not be guaranteed depending on academic performance and other factors.

-No application by the students is required for this scholarship.

-Those successfully selected will receive notification between late July and August from the university.

<Important Note>

- When you apply for “Meiji University Scholarship for Privately Financed International Students” and are successfully selected as recipient, you will automatically become ineligible for “Meiji University Graduate School Research Scholarship”.
- For the reason above, if you wish to prioritize the possibility of receiving “Meiji University Graduate School Research Scholarship”, please don’t apply for this scholarship.

<Concurrent Receipt of Other Scholarships>

- **Not Permitted** : Meiji University Graduate School Research Scholarship, Scholarships from external foundations that do not allow duplicate receipt.
- **Permitted** : Monbukagakusho Honors Scholarship for Privately-Financed International Students (JASSO), Meiji University Special Grant for Privately Financed International Students, Meiji University Grant for Academic Excellence for Privately Financed International Students, Scholarships from external foundations that allow duplicate receipt.

In case of other language, please refer to the FAQ. •If a lease agreement is not available, alternative documents (such as a dormitory application form) may be accepted.
2	Required	Certificate of Residence (The applicant's)	•<u>Must be issued within three months.</u> •"My Number" information should not be printed. •<u>Do not omit the "Status of Residence" field.</u> •We will verify the actual residency status at the property.
3	Optional (Required if applicable)	Certificate of Residence (The co-occupant's)	•<u>Required if there are other residents at the property such as in a shared room or living with relatives.</u> •<u>Do not omit the "Status of Residence" field.</u> •Must be issued within three months. •"My Number" information should not be printed.

3. Number of scholars and Screening

Number of scholars	Around 100 in total
Criteria for selection	Comprehensive assessments will be made based on the submitted documents.
Announcement of Results	•All applicants will be informed of their results through the Oh-o! Meiji system in late October 2026. •No inquiries about the selection results are accepted.

4. Grant amount

Stipend	50,000 JPY / month
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Payment period	Six months (October 2026 – March 2027)
Payment method	To be transferred to the recipient's bank account ● A lump-sum transfer of JPY 300,000 is scheduled for mid-December 2026. ● <u>The bank account must be with a bank in Japan and in the student's name.</u>
Revocation of Scholarship	The following circumstances may result in the revocation of your scholarship. The recipient shall be requested to return the paid scholarship to the university. (1) When the recipient takes a leave of absence or leaves the university. (2) When the recipient's student resident status changes to another status. (3) When the recipient is receiving other scholarships that do not allow duplicate receipt. (4) When false declarations are found. (5) When the recipient is deemed to be an inappropriate recipient for the scholarship award for any reason. (6) When the recipient is punished by the university.

5. Handling of Personal Information

Meiji University will use any submitted personal information only for the purpose of scholarship related matters, including screening, the decision-making process, and related office work. This is in compliance with the Meiji University Educational Foundation Personal Information Protection Policy and the Personal Information Protection Law and Regulations. Personal information will only be provided to a third party in compliance with laws and regulations, and never be used for other purposes.
