Application Guideline for Monbukagakusho Honors Scholarship Program for Reserved Applicants Fall AY 2025

1. Eligibility (Applicants must meet all the requirements)

- (1) Students with excellent personality, outstanding academic results and have difficulties in attending school for financial reasons
- (2) Students holding resident status of "Student" (or those in the process of changing their status to "Student")
- (3) Privately financed international students enrolled in a regular course of Meiji University (excluding exchange students)
- (4) Students who score 2.30 or above based on the last year's GPA in accordance with the following calculation method recognized by JASSO (and likely to maintain it during the period receiving scholarship).

In cases where the evaluation cannot be expressed in the form of GPA because of being newly admitted students etc., the student's evaluation result must be equivalent of 2.30 or above based on the results of the entrance examination, grades in home country, EJU results, or research achievements, etc.

(Number of S or A credits × 3) + (Number of B Credits × 2) + (Number of C Credits × 1) + (Number of F Credits × 0)

(5) Students who are not receiving over JPY90,000 per month in average as monthly allowance sent from financial supporters (excluding admission and tuition fees).

In case supporter is residing in Japan, the annual income of the supporter needs to be less than JPY 5,000,000

- (6) Students who do NOT receive other scholarships which prohibit joint supplying with Monbukagakusho Honors Scholarship
- (7) Students who are not scholars of "Meiji University International Students Incentive Scholarship Program"
 - XScholars of "Meiji University Special Grant for Privately Financed International Students" are eligible for this scholarship
- (8) Students who meet any of the following conditions
 - a) N2 level or above in Japanese-Language Proficiency Test (JLPT)
 - b) Score of 200 or above in Examination for Japanese University Admission for International Students (EJU) (reading, comprehension listening and listening-reading comprehension).
 - c) English ability: B2 level or above in Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR)
 - d) Other score which exceeds the language level specified by JASSO
- (9) Students who can cooperate with the survey regarding his/her future career. The survey will be conducted after the scholarship period.
- (10) Students who are NOT on a leave of absence from school, or repeating the year in the AY 2025
- (11) Students who are NOT subject to disciplinary action in AY 2025

| Scholar's Obligation | All recipients require to complete Monthly Attendance Report every month. The Monthly Attendance Report is a procedur to verify enrollment of recipients, and it requires to the recipients to visit the International Student Office and sign on the lisk kept in the office every month during designated period. Once you are nominated for the scholarship, you need to complet the Monthly Attendance Report in October and November. Signing periods are as follows. Please note if you fail to sign at the office within these periods, your nomination for the scholarship will be cancelled. Signing period for October: Early October Signing period for November: Early to mid-November (tentative) Details of the Monthly Attendance Report will be informed to the students determined to be nominated later via Oh-o! Meil of you do not sign during the specified period for each month, the scholarship will not be paid for that month. | | |
