These changes will be made as below to the "Application Guideline for Scholarships and Meiji University Tuition Assistance (Reduction) Program for Privately Financed International Students Enrolled in AY 2016" (Posted on March 17, 2016).

Amount of funding limit from other scholarships	Must be less than JPY 48,000	No limit. *Recipients must follow the regulation regarding accepting multiple awards set by each funding.
Submission of essay regarding studying abroad in Japan		Some recipients must submit an essay to share their experience of studying abroad in Japan. The essay will be published on the JASSO website.
Informing the post-graduatio n career to JASSO		Upon a request from JASSO, Meiji University will inform the recipients' grades, post-graduation career etc . to JASSO.
