

Meiji University Activity Restriction Guidelines

Under the Meiji University Activity Restriction Guidelines, the spread of the new-type coronavirus infection is divided into 6 stages from level 0 to 5, and defines the scope of each activity according to each level.

The Guidelines and actions are subject to change depending on future conditions. We will notify you of any new information through HP, Oh-o! Meiji etc.

●The current Level is 3(Orange).

Level 2 (Yellow)	Conditions that require high alert for infection (Increasing numbers of infected people in Tokyo, Chiba, Saitama, Kanagawa prefectures)	Classes are conducted online in principle. Some face-to-face classes with a limited number of students are held.	In principle, participation in and the sponsoring of research activities involving meetings at academic societies is prohibited. Research activities in the university are permitted with due consideration for the research environment.	In principle, students should refrain from entering the campus. Only some facilities approved by the university are available.	Activities are prohibited in principle. Only certain activities approved by the university are allowed.	In principle, make inquiries by e-mail or phone only. Consultation and submission of documents at the office can only be made with prior permission from the office.	Lending facilities to visitors are not available. Lending to faculty members is allowed but only for a limited number of people.	Face-to-face meetings are allowed but special attention must be paid to avoid spreading infection. Online or email meetings are preferred.
Level 3 (Orange)	<u>A state of emergency has been declared but a request to close a university has not been made</u> or A situation equal to a state of emergency without it being declared.	Online classes only.	In principle, research trips should be canceled. Participation in and sponsoring of meetings at academic societies is prohibited. As a general rule, research must be conducted at home, and entry into campus is possible only when necessary for educational and research preparation.	In principle, students should refrain from entering the campus. Only some facilities approved by the university are available.	[Athletic Association activities] Activities are prohibited in principle. Only certain activities approved by the university are allowed. [Club activities] Totally banned	In principle, make inquiries by e-mail or phone only. Consultation and submission of documents at the office can only be made with prior permission from the office.	No lending	Conduct meetings online or by email as much as possible.
Level 4 (Red)	A state of emergency has been declared <u>and a request to close a university has been made</u>	Online classes only.	In principle, research trips should be canceled. Participation in and sponsoring of meetings of academic societies is prohibited. As a general rule, research must be conducted at home, and entry into campus is possible only when necessary for educational and research preparation.	Entry is prohibited in principle. If it is necessary for students to enter the campus urgently, they must gain permission from their department or graduate school in advance. (Leave as soon as possible.)	Totally banned	Closed. Only contact by e-mail or phone.	No lending	In principle, meetings (except emergency management meetings), shall be conducted online or by email.
Level 5 (Black)	A serious emergency (A situation in which teachers and staff are unable to work due to the spread of infection, etc.)	Online classes only.	Only the minimum number of personnel necessary to maintain research assets is allowed.	All students are prohibited from entering any campus.	Totally banned	Closed. Only contact by e-mail or phone.	No lending	Online or email meetings only.
