Oh-o! Meiji System is learning support system used at Meiji University. This system is essential for university life: here you take online classes, download class materials, submit reports, and receive important information about classes.

You can connect your laptop or smartphone to the university network (MIND) and access services with wireless and wired LAN (using mobile information outlets). *Use of MIND network connection requires completion of MIND Introductory Course.

Meiji University has established rules for using the university network which was built for educational and research purposes. Failure to observe these rules could lead to severe punishment, including temporary or permanent loss of access to network service.

The university libraries provide various online services. For example, students can use the OPAC system to search for materials held by university libraries and other institutions. You can access databases, E-journals and E-books. You can use the Portal service to reserve books, to request delivery, etc.

Certificate issuing machines/Off-campus certificate issuance



Certificate issuing machines are used to obtain various kinds of certificates including student discount ones. To use the service, your student ID card and Meiji ID are needed. For the off-campus certificate issuance, apply for the service on the dedicated website, then print from the multi-copy machine at the convenience store.

Until May 6th: Complete MIND course and Multi-factor authentication setup!

New students are exempt from setting up Multi-factor authentication for some services and using the campus network (Wi-Fi and classroom PCs) until May 6th. If you do not complete the MIND seminar and Multi-factor authentication setup by this date, you will lose access to the internet from classroom PCs and Wi-Fi. Similarly, without setting up multi-factor authentication, you will not be able to log in to Oh-o! Meiji and others, which will significantly impact your university life. Completing MIND course and Multi-factor authentication setup after the deadline may require more time and costs. Please be sure to finish both before May 6th!
