
 Courses that apply toward credit limitations : All newly registered courses and repeat courses that are included in graduation requirements.
 *Exceptions: Practicum in Global Japanese Studies E, Internship in Japan, Volunteer Abroad Program, Study-Abroad Program
 For 4th year students, the lower limit for registering courses is 12 credits total throughout the 7th and 8th semester (rather than 6 credits for each semester).

Course registration: types of courses

- Required course: Courses that must be obtained
- Required elective course: Courses that must be obtained (select courses from certain category of courses)
- Electives: Courses that are not required or required elective




