

About Liberal Arts Studies A/B (SGJS course)

1. What kind of course is Liberal Arts Studies?

In Liberal Arts Studies courses, students will learn the basic knowledge, analytical skills, and presentation techniques required for a thorough understanding of the particular field of study.

Course type: Liberal Arts Studies is an elective required course in the “General Studies” category. Some courses are conducted in English (as type1).

Restrictions for registration: You can only register one Liberal Arts course per semester. You can register the course with the same title again in the following academic year or after, if it is held by a different instructor.

2. How to register

(1) Register the course in the web registration system.

If applicants exceed the student quota, the students may be selected by lottery.
