# Registration for Japanese language courses

### 1. Level of courses you can register

Refer to the level shown on the Japanese placement test system.

If you have obtained N1, you are automatically placed in Advanced level.

### 2. Registration method

## For students in *Introductory* to *Pre-Advanced* level

- 1) Check "Class Schedule" and find your classes' schedules.
- 2) Log in to Oh-o! Meiji system, search for your classes using "Class Search", and click "Self Enrollment". Make sure you self-enroll for both (General) and (Vocabulary & Kanji).
- 3) Attend the first class of (General) and (Vocabulary & Kanji).
- 4) Your registration will be completed in the first class.

### For students in Advanced level (Academic Japanese for International Students / Academic Writing in Japanese)

- 1) Check "Class Schedule" and find your classes' schedules.
- 2) Log in to Oh-o! Meiji system, search for your classes using "Class Search", and click "Self Enrollment".
- 3) Attend the first class
- 4) Submit the registration form to the School Office by [April 17, 10:00 am]. Download the registration form from the orientation website.

### JLPT Preparation courses

- 1) Check "Class Schedule" and find your classes' schedules.
- 2) Log in to Oh-o! Meiji system, search for your classes using "Class Search", and click "Self Enrollment".
- 3) Attend the first class(face-to-face)
- 4) Take a level check test. You can only register for the course if you are in the appropriate level. Your registration is complete in the first class.
- \* If you do not wish to register for the course after taking a level check test, please contact the professor in charge as soon as possible.

#### 3. Note

- 1) Make sure you attend the first class.
- 2) You cannot register for the Japanese courses using a registration system.
- 3) Note that Self Enrollment is not an official method to register for courses. It is only a supplement method to join the first week of classes.
