About SGJS Seminars

SGJS has a large selection of courses in seminar format, called "zemi. These interactive
courses have small class size and are taught by a professor specializing in that particular field
of study. Students decide their research themes, engage in discussions, and conduct research.
During the research process, students may collect information or do experiments for their
research results. Seminar students make a presentation and discuss their research results with
other members.

2. Schedule for each year

New first- and second-year students

In the AY2023 Fall Semester, there will be a screening for entering a seminar in the third year. We will announce details including the full schedule on Oh-o! Meiji at the end of July.

In the Webpage of GJS, you can see the schedule and the syllabus for AY2022. Please use this as a reference for thinking about your courses.

New third-year students

-About April Screening (Seminar Screening Period 3):

We have sent a notice to the students who can apply. Please make sure to check the instructions if you wish to apply.

-Course registration for your seminar

The School Office will register the seminars based on the Seminar Screening results (conducted in AY2022), but seminar courses will only be reflected in your classweb on April 19. Please remember to temporarily register for the course to join the class before the formal registration completes.

New fourth-year students

-Course registration for your seminar

The School Office will register for the seminar based on the course registration in the AY2022 Fall semester, but seminar courses will only be reflected in your class web on April 19. Please remember to self-enroll for the course to join the class before the formal registration completes.

*The seminar with the same instructor you belonged to in the AY2022 Fall semester (Seminar B for 3rd year) will be registered for your 4th year (Seminar A/B).

*In the first class, there will be a final confirmation of the students joining each seminar course. Please be especially careful not to miss the first class.

-Changing your seminar after you enter

If you wish to change the seminar you are enrolled in, make sure to seek permission from the instructors of both your current seminar and the seminar you wish to enter. After getting permission, the instructor will report the School Office about the change, and will proceed with the registration.

-Leaving your seminar / Joining a new seminar

If you wish to leave your seminar or newly join a seminar this semester, please seek permission from the seminar instructor. After getting permission, the instructor will report the School Office about the change, and will proceed with the registration.

If you took a leave of absence in the AY2020 Fall Semester

If you wish to register after taking a leave of absence, please check in advance with the seminar instructor. Please also remember to register temporarily when joining the first class.

*If you were not able to take the Seminar Screening test because of your leave of absence, please directly contact the instructor in charge. Please note that some seminars have already closed their application.

Fourth-year students who are repeating the year

If you are repeating your fourth year, the seminar will not be registered by the office. If you wish to join a seminar, please check in advance with the seminar instructor. Please also remember to temporarily register when joining the first class. After getting permission, the instructor will report the School Office about the change, and will proceed with the registration.

*If you have already earned credits for Seminar A/B, you cannot register for seminars again.
