

About Liberal Arts Studies A/B (SGJS course)

1. Notes on the new course title

From AY 2019, there has been a change in the course title and categorization of Liberal Arts Studies. If your enrollment year is AY2018 or earlier, please carefully read 4. Changes in the course title.

2. What kind of course is Liberal Arts Studies?

In Liberal Arts Studies courses, students will learn the basic knowledge, analytical skills, and presentation techniques required for a thorough understanding of the particular field of study.

Course type: Liberal Arts Studies is an elective required course in the “General Studies” category. Some courses are conducted in English (as type1).

Restrictions for registration: You can only register one Liberal Arts course per semester. You can register the course with the same title again in the following academic year or after, if it is held by a different instructor.

3. How to register ※New instructions from this academic year※

- (1) Register the course in the web registration system.

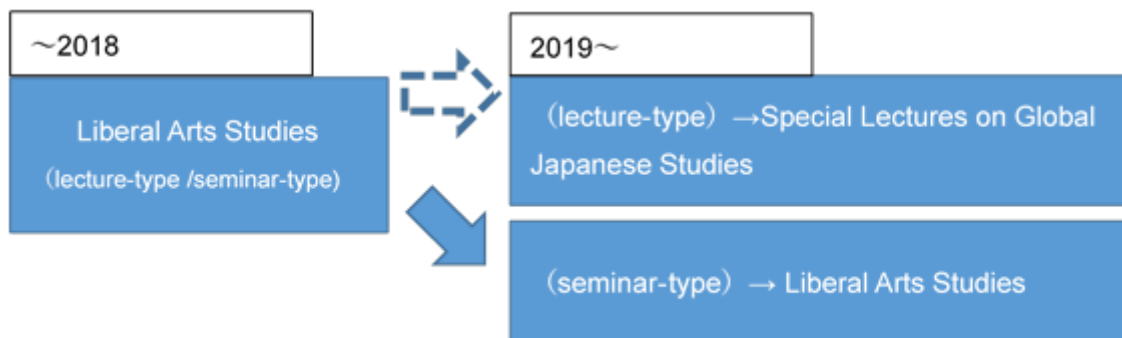
If applicants exceed the student quota, the students may be selected by screening or lottery. Please read the Syllabus carefully before you register.

- (2) Check your individual class schedule

※ If you did not pass screening for a course but register for it, the course will be deleted from your registration. You will not be able to register another course in place of the deleted course. Please note that the screenings are held separately for the Spring and Fall semester. (If you pass the screening for the Spring Semester, this does not guarantee the same for the Fall Semester.)

4. Changes in the course title ※ For students who enrolled on or before AY2018

Until AY2018, Liberal Arts Studies had two types of courses: lecture-type courses and seminar-type courses. From AY2019, the course name Liberal Arts Studies is only used for the seminar-type courses. The lecture-type courses are now called “Special Lectures on Global Japanese Studies.”



If you registered a lecture-type Liberal Arts Studies course on or before AY2018, you cannot register Special Lectures on Global Japanese Studies held by the same instructor. (This only applies to the course, “Special Lectures on Global Japanese Studies” by Prof. Numata.

As exceptions, if you registered Liberal Arts Studies (lecture-type) by Prof. Watari or Prof. Matsumoto on or before AY2018, you can still register Special Lectures on Global Japanese Studies held by the same instructor. These exceptional cases cannot be registered for in the web registration system. If you wish to register, please apply at the Nakano Academic Affairs Office by Wednesday, April 15.
