

Registration Method for Japanese Language Courses at SGJS

**The Japanese language courses, ranging from Introductory to Advanced levels, are available exclusively to exchange students and English Track degree-seeking students at School of Global Japanese Studies (SGJS).

1. Level of courses you can register for

- 2026 April new incoming students: Refer to the level shown on the Japanese placement test system.
- Continuing students from AY 2025 Fall: Your class in the AY2026 Spring will be determined based on the academic record of Japanese Language Courses from the AY2025 Fall.

2. Registration / Withdrawal method

For students in **Introductory to Pre-Advanced level**

- 1) You will be automatically registered in courses based on the placement test results.
- 2) **If you do not want to enroll in the courses, please remove the course(s) through the WEB course registration system during the designated course registration period, which includes the registration period for courses with a maximum class size. Please note that the Japanese language courses "General" and "Vocabulary & Kanji" must be registered or deleted as a complete set; they cannot be removed individually.**

[NOTE] If you earned credits for the “General” course but did not earn any credits for “Vocabulary & Kanji” in the Fall semester of AY 2025, and you would like to register for the upper-level “General” course as well as the failed “Vocabulary & Kanji” course in the Spring semester of AY 2026, please consult with the School of Global Japanese Studies Office. This type of registration cannot be completed through the online course registration system.

For students in **Advanced level**
