1. About Registration

Q	A
Q1-1: When are the registration period?	<p>There are three times to register.</p> <p>1st (maximum class size) April 7 10:00am ~ April 8 11:00am</p> <p>2nd (maximum class size and other courses) April 16 10:00am ~ April 17 1:00pm</p> <p>3rd (fix period) April 21 10:00am ~ April 23 1:00pm</p>
Q1-2:How to search the courses ?	<p>Please download a timetable by here, then search the courses. You can also get details about the courses at Oh-o! Meiji.</p>
Q1-3: Are there the courses which exchange students cannot take?	<p>You cannot take the required courses for original students.</p>
Q1-4: What is Provisional Enrollment?	<p>The purpose of “Provisional enrollment” is to make the Class Web for the subject available on the Oh-o! Meiji system before your individual timetable is fixed.</p> <p>For most classes held between April 10 and April 17, you will need to use this temporary participation function to attend the class.</p> <p>reference : How to register as a provisional participant</p>
Q1-5: How to register?	<p>Please use Academic Affair System to register.</p> <p>WEB Course Registration Method is here.</p>
Q1-6: I would like to take other faculty's courses.	<p>Please register between April 16 10:00am ~ April 17 1:00pm via Academic Affair System. If the course name appeared in the system, you can take the course. If not, you cannot take the course.</p> <p>*We cannot answer individual inquiries regarding whether you are eligible to take that course.</p>
Q1-7: How many credits I have to take?	<p>There are no minimum credits for exchange students. Please consul your home university. Maximum credits are 24.</p>

Q2-1: Do I have to take Japanese language courses?	You are not required to take this course. Please choose based on your personal circumstances. If you would like to enroll, you must take the placement test administered in March.
Q2-2: Can I choose the level by myself?	No, you cannot choose by yourself. Please attend the class at the level you have been assigned.
Q2-3: How do I register for Japanese language courses?	Please refer to the " Registration for Japanese language courses " on the guidance SGJS Exchange student Orientation website.
Q2-4: How do I register for advanced classes?

Q3-5: How can I purchase a train pass?	Please consult with the station staff at Nakano Station or at your nearest station.
Q3-6: I would like a student discount card.	You can obtain it at the certificate issuance machine in front of the 3rd floor office. There is no charge for issuance.
