
How to book your visit (Please apply on the day you will visit)


2. Login to the common authentication system account with your student ID number and select "Apply."

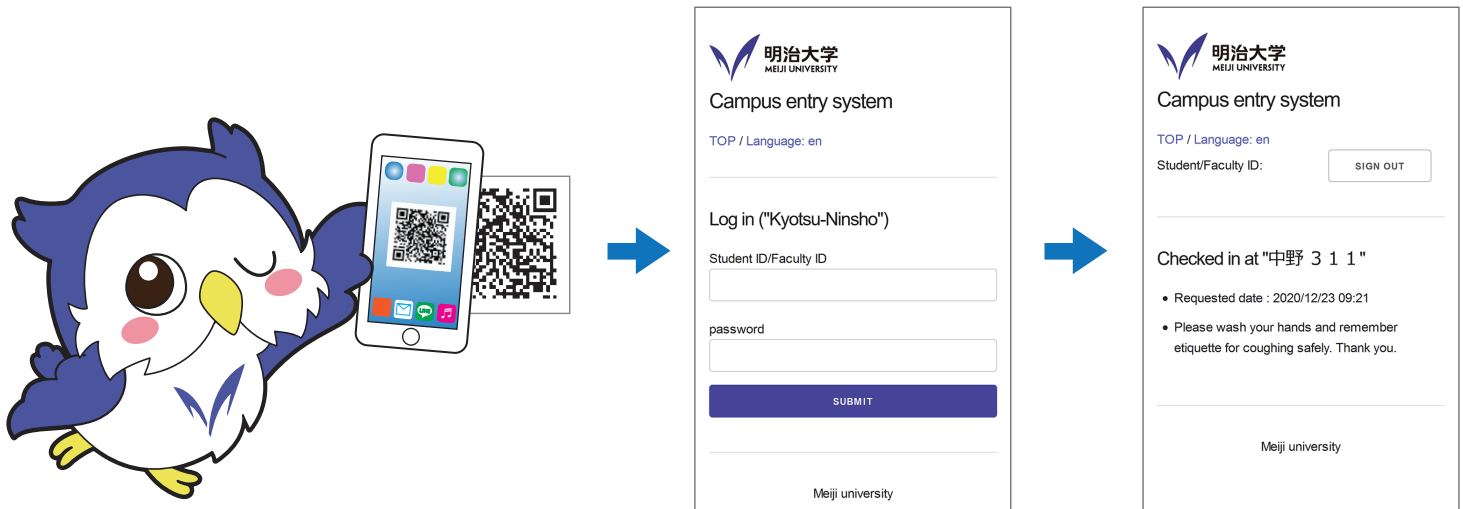
4. When entering the Nakano Campus building, please hold your Student ID card over the IC card reader.



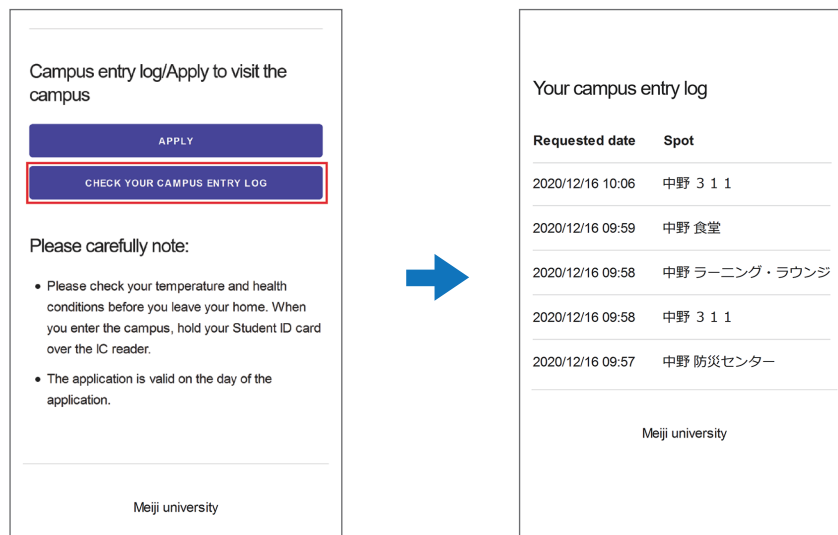
# QR codes are available in the classrooms to log your campus visit.
