Meiji University requests the suspension or postponement of extracurricular activities

(ongoing or planned) that fall within any of the following definitions:

(1) Domestic and overseas training camps and expeditions

(2) Practice matches, etc. (To be discussed with the other party)

\*In principle, participation in national and international tournaments and official games

is basically determined by the relevant sports federations.

(3) Events and concerts held inside or outside the university involving outsiders in any

capacity

(4) Events involving a high possibility of close contact between participants, such as social

gatherings and farewell parties.

\*If in doubt, consult the Student Support Office regarding Club activities (extracurricular

activities desk) or the Sports Promotion Office regarding PE activities.

Academic facilities such as classrooms, gymnasiums, and club rooms should be avoided.

Appropriate measures such as thorough handwashing and gargling, and staying at home

should be taken until the new coronavirus infection situation subsides. This request has

had a great impact on the activities of the clubs etc, and although it is quite disappointing

to all those who have been preparing for events, the university has decided not to let club

activities become the cause of the spread of infection. We ask for your understanding and

cooperation in preventing the spread of new coronavirus infections in Japan. We all look

forward to welcoming our new students in a normal educational environment starting in

the new fiscal year.
