<Overview of Revisions>

[Continue to conduct online classes during the S2 period] Online classes will start on May 7. During the Spring Semester (S1 and S2) period, in principle, online classes will be continued. If the "Meiji University Activity Restriction Guidelines" for preventing the spread of new coronavirus infection is lowered to level 2 or lower due to the situation of new coronavirus infection in the future, face—to—face classes may be started in some classes. In that case, we will inform you at least two weeks before the start of the face—to—face class.

[Holiday compensation class day via online classroom]
Every Saturday during S2 period will be designated as online class Holiday compensation class day which
